The 2025-2026 season will feature four classical concerts which will explore "a wild orchestra ride," musical sketches, a child's view of heaven, old favorites and rediscovered pieces.

Music Director and Conductor Michelle Merrill describes our programming this way: "This is a regional orchestra that stands out above the many others I have worked with because of the high-level of playing, as well as the adaptability to varying styles – classical, romantic, modern, jazzy – **they really can do it all!**"

During the Season our more intimate SoundBites with smaller ensembles will include cocktails and conversation with the musicians in interesting venues around town. The Musical Mentors program is underway in area schools, and a gala event is being planned for 2026.




EXPRESSIONS

Our opening concert of the season brings us lyrical music expressing emotion in imaginative and descriptive ways.



Ballade has been called a clever young man's piece, a wild orchestra ride brimming with invention and energy. Nineteenth Century English composer Samuel Coleridge-Taylor, known in his time as "The Black Mahler," offers soulful melodies, dramatic story telling, and lots of energy.



Edvard Grieg's Lyric Suite is rooted in the national folk tradition of Norway and is noted for a refined lyrical sense, music that catches your ear in a unique way that might be called singable. Listen for musical poems of a Shepherd Boy, a Norwegian March, a Notturno (dreamy nighttime reflection) and a March of the Trolls.



Nineteenth Century English composer **Sir Edward William Elgar**'s *Enigma Variations* closes the performance. It consists of musical sketches of individuals which he said expresses his friends pictured within that "commenced in a spirit of humor [and] continued in deep seriousness." It is a bit like solving a puzzle – what is the enigma?
